

AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN INTERCITY TRANSIT  
AND  
SOUTH PUGET SOUND COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This AGREEMENT is made and entered into in duplicate this 8<sup>th</sup> day of Sept., 2000, by and between INTERCITY TRANSIT, a public transportation benefit area of the State of Washington, hereinafter referred to as "TRANSIT", and SOUTH PUGET SOUND COMMUNITY COLLEGE, hereinafter referred to as "COLLEGE".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the student body at COLLEGE have authorized the collection of a per credit fee for the purpose of providing bus service to all students enrolled in credit bearing classes; and,

WHEREAS, TRANSIT and COLLEGE have a long-standing program that provides students enrolled in credit bearing classes unrestricted and unlimited travel on local transit services;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, conditions, covenants, and performance contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Agreement are as follows:

- (a) To encourage transit use as an alternative to automobile use by COLLEGE's students.
- (b) To reduce traffic congestion and parking demand on and around the COLLEGE campus.

2. PROGRAM

This Agreement continues a transit pass program for students of COLLEGE enrolled in credit bearing and credit equivalent classes. TRANSIT will allow eligible students unrestricted and unlimited ridership on all local routes and schedules, including regular fixed route service and Dial-A-Lift service. The Olympia/Tacoma Express, vanpool services offered by TRANSIT and service operated by another transit agency are not part of this agreement.

Eligible students must show their current, validated, Associated Student Body identification card (ASB card) to the bus operator when boarding. To be accepted, the ASB card must bear a current validation, in the form of a sticker with the appropriate color and academic quarter notation.

The use of a valid ASB card is subject to the following schedule:

- Fall session cards are valid from September 11, 2000 until January 12, 2001.
- Winter session cards are valid from December 26, 2000 until April 6, 2001.
- Spring session cards are valid from March 26, 2001 until June 29, 2001.
- Summer session cards are valid from June 18, 2001 until September 21, 2001.

### 3. AGREEMENT TERM

This Agreement is effective on September 11, 2000. The initial term of this Agreement shall be from the effective date until September 22, 2001, and will continue from year to year unless terminated. For each subsequent year, the extension of the agreement is subject to a renegotiation of all terms.

### 4. PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

COLLEGE shall fund service provided under the transit pass program. COLLEGE shall remit funds to TRANSIT equal to forty-eight cents (\$0.48) per credit hour per registered student enrolled in credit bearing classes by the tenth day of each academic quarter. At the same time, COLLEGE shall provide TRANSIT with a count of students enrolled in credit bearing, and credit equivalent, classes as of the tenth day of each academic quarter.

### 5. PROGRAM PROMOTION

The costs of program marketing and promotion are the responsibility of TRANSIT.

### 6. REPORTS AND EVALUATION

To facilitate program review and evaluation, TRANSIT will develop and maintain program performance reports summarizing student ridership and other relevant information. Annual ridership estimates will be based upon two physical counts of students boarding TRANSIT vehicles with an ASB Card. COLLEGE and TRANSIT will mutually determine the dates of these physical counts.

Records of these physical counts will be available for inspection, review, or audit by personnel duly authorized by COLLEGE. Performance reports and other records will be maintained by TRANSIT for a period of three years, in accordance with the time period required for a State audit, or as required by any other law, whichever is longer. TRANSIT shall allow COLLEGE access to required records for the purposes of monitoring and evaluating performance.

### 7. CHANGES

The PARTIES may request changes to this Agreement. Any such changes that are mutually agreed upon shall be incorporated herein by written amendment to the Agreement.

### 8. TERMINATION

Termination for Convenience. Either party may terminate this Agreement. Such termination shall only occur at the end of an academic quarter.

Termination for Cause. Failure by either party to comply with the terms of this Agreement shall constitute material breach of contract and is cause for termination. In the event of such termination during an academic quarter after the disbursement of funds to TRANSIT, TRANSIT shall return all unearned revenue to COLLEGE prorated on a per diem basis.

### 9. ENTIRE CONTRACT

This Agreement is the complete expression of the terms hereto and any oral representations or understandings not incorporated herein are excluded.



2. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement remain unchanged.


