- Authorized the General Manager to execute a one-year contract extension with American Custodial, Inc., for Janitorial Services and Supplies for the Olympia Transit Center, Lacey Transit Center, Amtrak Centennial Station and Pattison Street Facilities in an amount not-to-exceed \$124,934, including tax. - Authorized the General Manager to enter into a three-year contract with Urban Solar Corporation for solar lighting solutions for bus stops with two, one-year contract extension options; and to purchase 20 solar units in the amount of \$27,636.00, including tax.
- Scheduled a special meeting for Wednesday, September 21, 2016, to conduct a joint meeting of the Authority and the Citizen Advisory Committee. (Ann Freeman-Manzanares).
