Federal Mask Mandate Extended through April 18, 2022



The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has extended the Federal Mask Mandate through Monday, April 18, 2022. Wearing a mask while on transit vehicles and inside transit buildings is required.

A Look Ahead: Service Update



Schedules for our routes will not change in March as they typically do during our bi-annual service changes. However, due to limited staffing at this time, the following changes are to remain in effect:

- The One remains suspended.
- Route 13 continues to operate on 30-minute frequency.

We will reintroduce The One and increase frequency on Route 13 as soon as staffing levels allow.

Walk N Roll's 2021 Program Report



Despite the impacts of COVID-19, in 2021, Intercity Transit's Walk N Roll youth education program continued to find

new and creative ways to provide education and encouragement on active and public transportation to youth and families in our community. All their work is made possible through strong partnerships with school districts, city and county government and local community organizations.

- With help from partners, the program distributed over 500 traffic safety yard signs encouraging drivers to slow down and make our roads safer for people walking and rolling.
- They helped install the first permanent traffic garden in Thurston County.
- They aided in the distribution of 237 free helmets to youth in need.
- They provided bicycle education classes and 18 youth with refurbished bicycles.
- They organized a Winter Bicycle Scavenger Hunt that encouraged 113 youth and families to get outside and be active.

Earn-A-Bike Offering Remote Learning Class



Intercity Transit's Earn-A-Bike program is offering a virtual class to Thurston County youth ages 11 to 17 through local parks and recreation programs. Sign-up for the online class and earn a refurbished bicycle for only \$5 through the end of March!

The class teaches youth essential bicycle safety and maintenance skills to prepare them to ride their bicycle safely and independently.

Students have two weeks to complete a series of online video-based lessons and quizzes. The class takes about one hour to complete. Upon successful completion of these quizzes, students will be offered a refurbished bicycle, helmet and accessories.
