What is a Vanpool?

- A vanpool is a group of three or more people
- Who share a similar commute
- Intercity Transit provides the van, fuel, insurance, and maintenance
- Individuals pay a low monthly fare based on daily round-trip miles or a daily trip fare
- In some cases, employers cover a portion or all the fare for their employees

2022 – A Year of Change

- ITA approved simplified flat rate fare structure moving from over 2000 price points down to 8
- Flat rate fare implementation began in January
- Manual fare calculations and invoicing began in January
- Vanpool management software purchased to support the fare structure change and improve customer experience
- Fare calculations and invoicing automated in December
- Fare payments received through payment portal integrated with software
- Automatic payment function option available for customers
- Electronic employer subsidy payment options receivable through payment portal or wire transfer
- Paper subsidy vouchers used by State agencies were replaced with electronic payment methods improving employer invoicing, subsidy tracking, and employee and employer access

Flat Rate Fare update

- Thanks to the ITA and CAC for supporting fare structure changes
- 65 new vanpool groups formed in 2022
- 337 new vanpool participants
- 4351 Daily Trips in 2022 – zero in past years
- Daily Trip Riders work hybrid work schedules

Flat Rate Fare

The Flat Rate Vanpool Fare **is simple and affordable**. In addition, we have a daily trip option for those with hybrid work schedules. The Flat Rate Vanpool fare is summarized below.

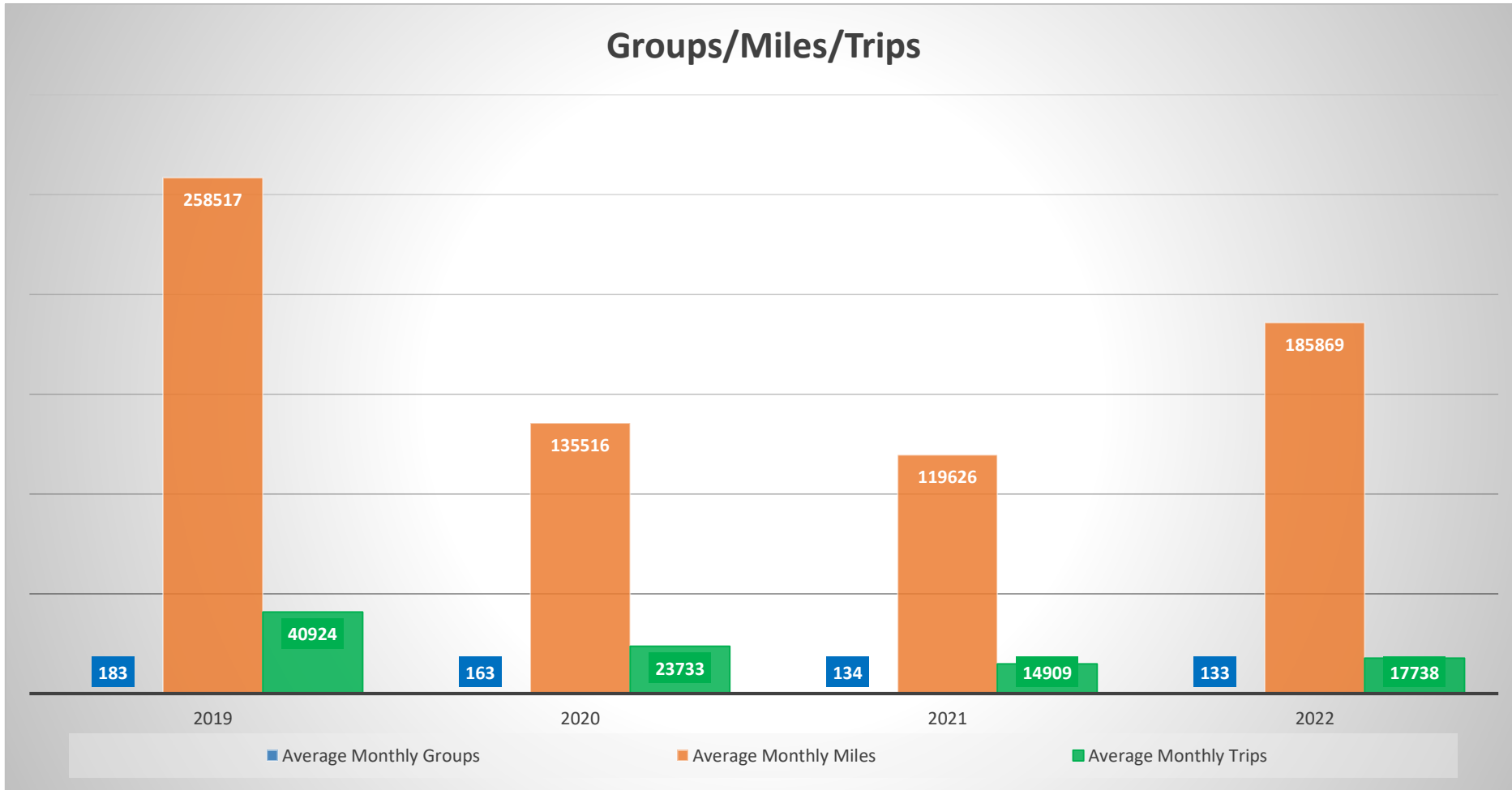

Pandemic Data 2019 - 2022

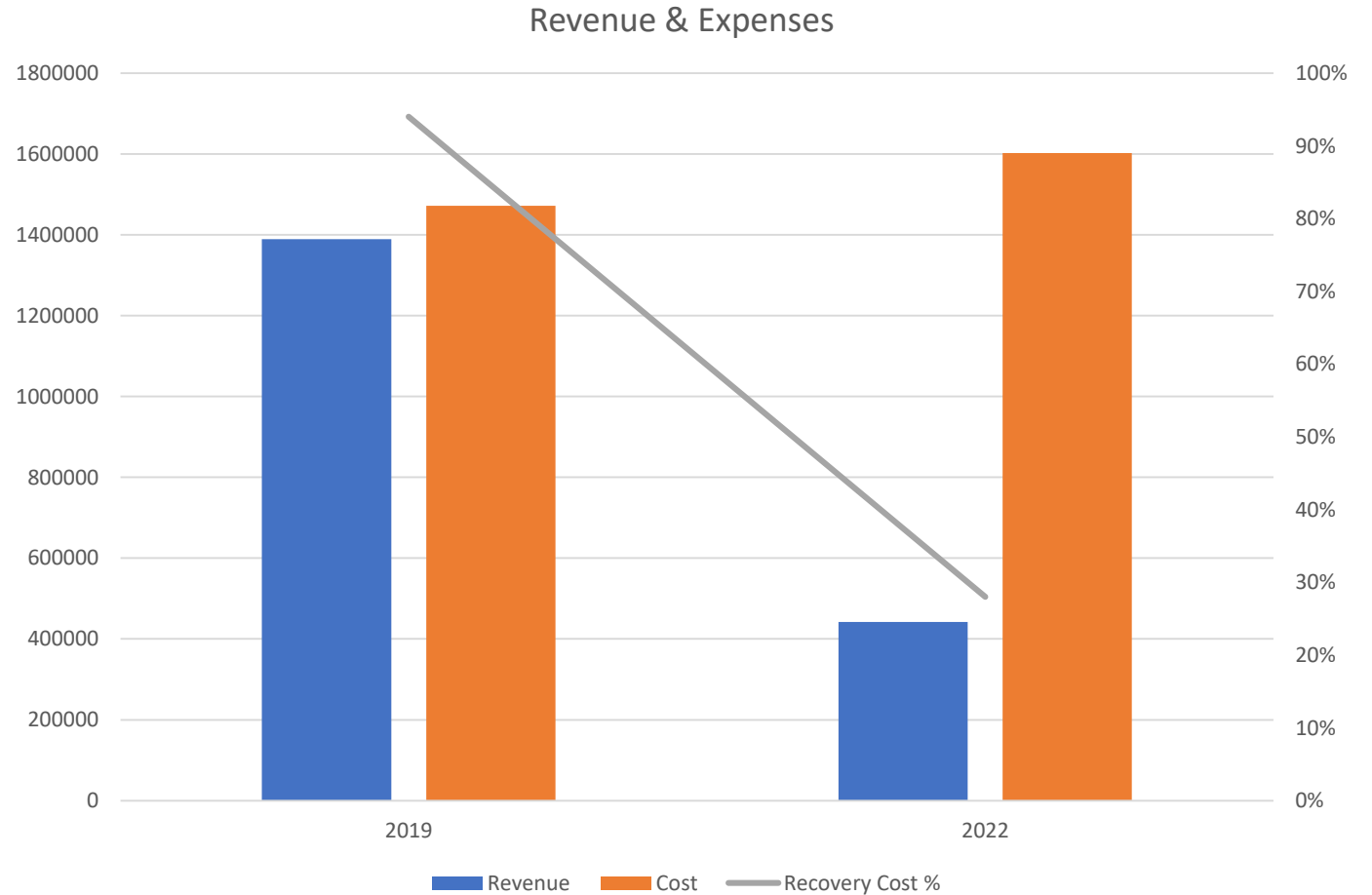


Trips and Miles and Groups

- 2021-2022 Trips increased 16%
- 2021-2022 Miles Traveled increased 36%
- 2021-2022 Groups – slight change (134-133)
- 2019-2022 Trips decreased 57%
- 2019-2022 Miles Traveled decreased 28%
- 2019-2022 Groups decreased 27%
- Summary – Vanpool groups are at 74% of pre-pandemic stats

Revenue and Expenses 2019 vs 2022

- 2022 revenue collected = \$441,965
- 2019 revenue collected = \$1,389,143
- 2022 expenses = \$1,602,526
- 2019 expenses = \$1,471,873
- 2022 cost recovery = 28%
- 2019 cost recovery = 94%
- 2022 Cost/Trip = \$7.52
- 2019 Cost/Trip = \$3.00

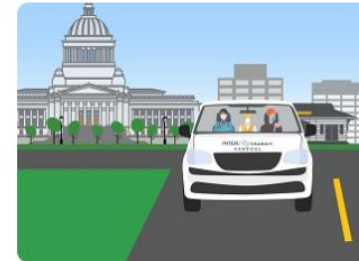

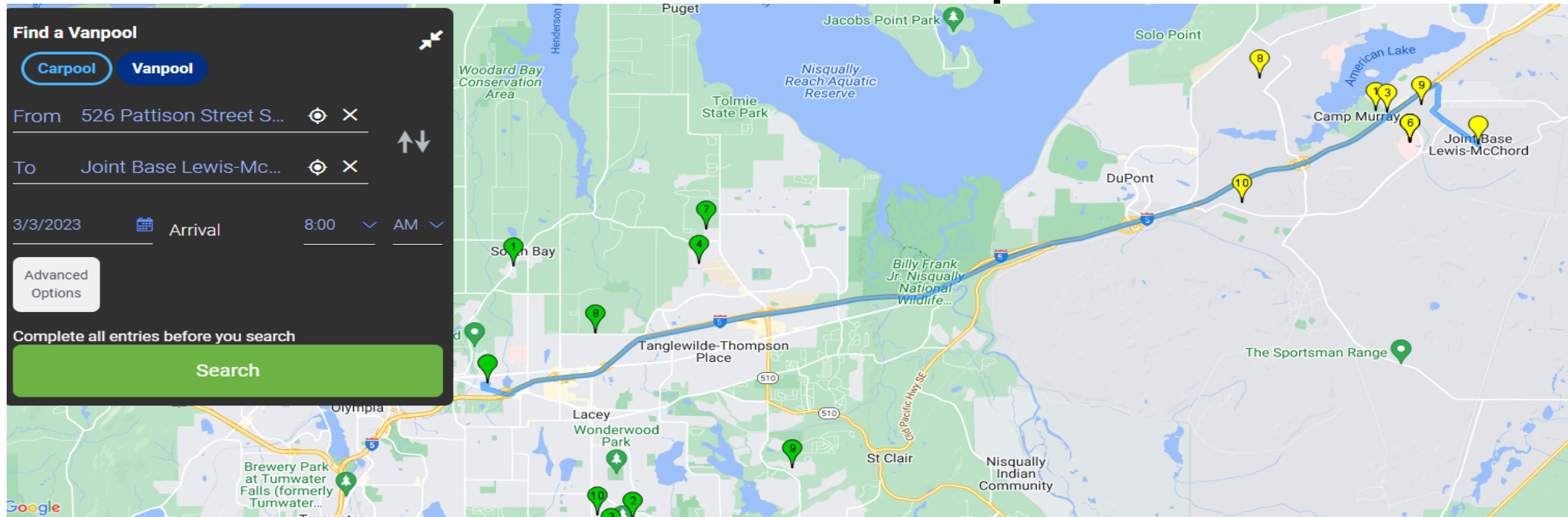

Recruitment Incentives

- Recruitment incentives are offered for referrals to Vanpool
- Person referring receives \$100 Amazon gift card/referral
- In 2022 there were 216 referrals, totaling \$21,600
- Subsidize 1st Month Free, totaling \$15,945
- Subsidy and incentives applied to matching fund expenditures for WSDOT RMG Business to Business - \$55,000 local match

To or From Thurston County

- Intercity Transit vanpool customers must commute either to or from Thurston County
- Thurston-Thurston County commute = 15%
- Thurston – Other County commute = 43%
- Other County – Thurston commute = 26%
- Other – Other = 16%

- Exceptions – The VANPOOL must travel to or from Thurston County. Some vanpool customers are along the route and their origin or destination may not be in Thurston County. JBLM & Madigan customers may not be in Thurston County

- 2021-2023 WSDOT RMG Business to Business VP Marketing awarded \$220,000 with \$55,000 Local Match – SHOUT OUT TO WSDOT! We were approved to use 100% to support the purchase of the vanpool management software which was needed to support the flat rate fare structure. ITA approved purchase for \$289,102
- New WSDOT Vanpool Investment Program Marketing Grant awarded \$55,000 – no local match
- Total grant fund used for promotional mailer in 2023
- WSDOT VIP awarded for \$324,000 for 12 2023 Toyota Sienna Hybrids - arrived February
- Grant funding covers approximately 71% of cost or \$27,000 per vehicle
- Total purchase amount \$455,760 with \$131,760 remaining

- Annually, if qualified vans are available, Intercity Transit grants vehicles to eligible nonprofit or community organizations in our service district through a competitive review and award process
- Applications are accepted and reviewed by a panel consisting of our GM, VP Manager, 1 VP staff, 2 community members
- Maintenance Director and Vanpool Manager select vans for retirement and receive ITA approval
- The number of vans and number of SVG applicants are considered in the process along with funding criteria
- 2021 – 15 vans were granted
- 2022 – no retired vans met the funding criteria, so the SVG was not offered
