SUBJECT: Bus Shelter Purchase

- 1) The Issue: Consideration of issuing a purchase order for the purchase of bus stop shelters and associated kiosks to replenish depleted inventory.
- **2)** Recommended Action: Authorize the General Manager to execute a purchase order to Handi-Hut Inc. for the purchase of shelters in the amount of \$133,450, not including tax.
- 3) Policy: The Procurement Policy states the Authority must approve any expenditure over \$100,000.
- **Background:** Intercity provides shelters throughout our system to provide cover during inclement weather and bring attention to our stops. The shelters are robust; however, they are subject to occasional accidents that cause them to be unusable. Our inventory of spare shelters is depleted, and our facilities team needs to place an order.

Intercity solicited bids for 14 shelters, to replenish our inventory (three full size, and eleven cantilever, as well as kiosks to accompany the shelters.

Transit issued a request for bids on March 9th and two bids were submitted by the due date of March 20th. The pricing includes the shelters, kiosks, freight, and structural certified drawings and calculations. Both bids were determined to be responsive. Handi-Hut submitted the lowest most cost-effective bid and had the most advantageous estimated delivery time. Transit has previously purchased shelters from Handi-Hut and was satisfied with their product. Accordingly, staff recommends issuing a purchase order to Handi-Hut.

5) Alternatives:

- **A.** Authorize the General Manager to execute a purchase order to Handi-Hut Inc for the purchase of shelters in the amount of \$133,450, not including tax.
- **B.** Defer action. A decision to delay may impact our ability to replace shelters damaged beyond repair in a timely manner.

- **Budget Notes:** The 2023 budget has \$150,000 allocated for this purchase.
- 7) Goal Reference: Goal 2: Provide outstanding customer service. Goal 3: Maintain a safe and secure operating system. Goal 6: Encourage use of our services, reduce barriers to access and increase ridership.

Reference






